Now we will ask you some questions about future behaviors and uncertain outcomes. In each case, try to think about the whole range of possibilities and think about how likely they are to

occur. In these questions, we will ask you about the percent chance of something happening. The percent chance must be a number from 0 to 100. You can also give numbers after the decimal point. Here are some descriptions corresponding to different chances of something happening:

Absolutely will not happen = 0 % chance A very
small chance = Less than 1% chance A small chance = 2 to 15 % chance
A reasonable chance = 15 to 40 % chance A
pretty even chance = 40 to 60% chance A big chance = 60 to 85 % chance
A very big chance = 85 to 98 % chance Almost
certain = More than 99% chance Absolutely certain = 100% chance You
can also think of percent chance as the number of times something happens out of 100.
