Both kinds of visits can be with a personal doctor who you also see in-person OR with an unfamiliar doctor you have never seen in-person. 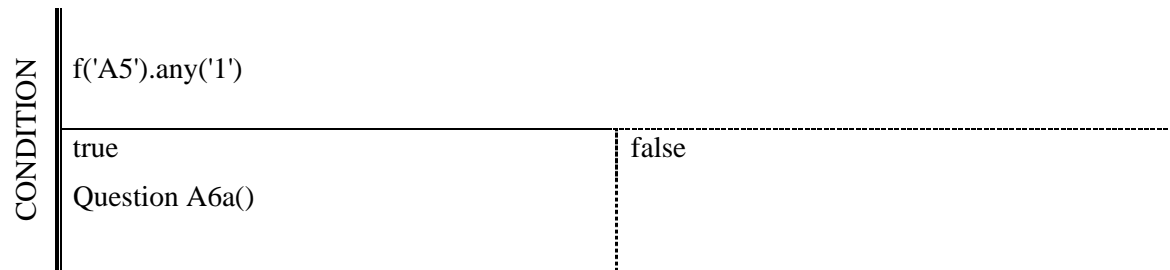

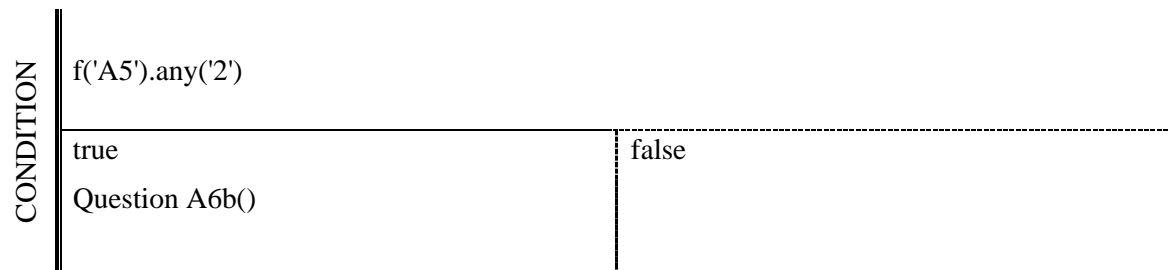
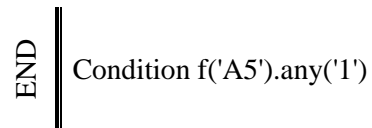
