In these questions, we will ask you about the percent chance of something happening. The percent chance must be a number from 0 to 100. You can also give numbers after the decimal point. Here are some descriptions corresponding to different chances of something happening:

Absolutely will not happen = 0 % chance    A very  
small chance = Less than 1% chance    A small chance = 2 to 15 % chance  
A reasonable chance = 15 to 40 % chance    A pretty  
even chance = 40 to 60% chance    A big chance = 60 to 85 % chance  
A very big chance = 85 to 98 % chance    Almost  
certain = More than 99% chance    Absolutely certain = 100% chance You  
can also think of percent chance as the number of times something happens out of 100.
