#### Intro Introduction

For the purposes of this survey, the term "household emergency" refers to an unexpected expense or an unexpected drop in income faced by your household. Examples of unexpected expenses include unexpected medical expenses, car repair, house or apartment repair, an unexpected expense for one's kids, a funeral or other expenses your household did not anticipate. An unexpected drop in income might occur due to an unexpected cut in work hours or reduced number of work shifts, or temporary or permanent job loss by a member of your household.
